Here at Still Hopes we wish to be as transparent as possible when it comes to our Coronavirus statistics. We closely monitor the county positivity rates for both Richland and Lexington counties to guide our actions as they relate to the Coronavirus pandemic. Still Hopes looks to DHEC in regards to Coronavirus statistics and numbers.

The current county positivity rate for Lexington County is **5.7%**. The current county positivity rate for Richland County is **4.5%**. While we monitor both positivity rates, we mostly look to Lexington County because that is where our campus is physically located. Since these positivity rates are below 10%, all applicable departments are devising plans for a gradual return to normalcy here on our campus. Once these plans are finalized, they will be communicated to you.
