- Telemedicine is a good option for many non-emergent conditions like allergies, a cold or flu, pink eye, headaches, and nausea
- You can save a lot of time with telemedicine avoid waiting for an appointment, driving to the doctor's office, and sitting in the waiting room – you can connect with a telemedicine doctor in just 6 minutes on average
- The best part? Telemedicine is low-cost \$50 is the national average and your plan may even be less expensive. Compare that to \$150 on average for an urgent care visit.
- Telemedicine services are effective too, over 95% of patients are satisfied with the virtual care they receive
